




NASIHAH

CHANGE OF SCHOOL OPENING HOURS

The additional time for Key Stage 3 (KS3) will be allocated to form classes, longer assemblies, and extended lessons. Additionally, the school day for Key Stage 4 (KS4) will end slightly earlier allowing them to finish at 4:30pm. Our KS4 boosters can also become more beneficial, as instead of a 30-minute short



session, it will last for 45 minutes-1 hour, achieving a great deal more. This adjustment is part of our longterm strategy to achieve excellence in all areas of the school. We kindly ask for your support in making this transition smooth and effective.




