CHANGE OF SCHOOL OPENING HOURS

For the upcoming academic year, the school will begin the day at **8am**. This change, discussed during our last parent conference, is crucial for enhancing our safeguarding measures. The additional time for Key Stage 3 (KS3) will be allocated to form classes, longer assemblies, and extended lessons. Additionally, the school day for Key Stage 4 (KS4) will end slightly earlier allowing them to finish at 4:30pm. Our KS4 boosters can also become more beneficial, as instead of a 30-minute short session, it will last for 45 minutes -1 hour, achieving a great deal more. This adjustment is part of our long-term strategy to achieve excellence in all areas of the school. We kindly ask for your support in making this transition smooth and effective.
