Please note that all student fees must be paid promptly. Any delay in payment may lead to deregistration from the school. **In addition, there is a refundable deposit of £500.** This deposit will normally be refunded at the end of the student's education at Darul Uloom, as long as all fees have been cleared (**terms and conditions apply, please see below**).

Terms and Conditions

1. Disclosure of all previous character and conduct is necessary. The application will be rejected if any information is given falsely.

The school maintains strict adherence to basic Islamic principles of good conduct, behaviour, and respect. Above all, students are required to respect all teachers, staff, and fellow students. Any student found guilty of insulting teachers, staff, or fellow students will be judged as inexcusable and may be excluded temporarily or permanently.
Students are expected to observe and act upon the lesson timetables. While at Darul Uloom, all lessons and examinations must be attended.

- 4. School uniforms, as prescribed in pre-admission documents, must be worn at all times during school hours students are to maintain their hair according to the school
- uniform guidance and ensure it is of equal length. Untidy hair, fades, and short backs or sides are not permissible. (See Behaviour Policy)
- 5. Students must participate in all curricular, extracurricular activities and booster classes assigned by the teachers.
- 6. School premises such as classrooms, wudu areas, and toilets must be kept clean by the students.
- 7. Should a student cause any damage to the school's or others property, their parents or guardians will be held responsible for the full cost of repair or replacement. 8. Students will not possess a smart mobile device for the duration of their education at the school. If found in possession of one, Darul Uloom reserves the right to
- confiscate and retain the device(s) for the duration of his education at Darul Uloom. (See Search and Confiscation Policy)
- 9. Missing prayers, theft, smoking, vaping, using drugs, or inappropriate relationships are strictly prohibited, and students involved in any such activity are liable for permanent exclusion. All students are expected to fast during Ramadan unless medically exempt.
- 10. No student is allowed to leave school premises during school hours. (See attendance policy)
- 11. Any student leaving the school premises without authorisation will be cautioned and may result in exclusion.
- 12. Parents or guardians may contact the school office to request leave in cases of emergency or dire necessity. Please note that the school will not authorise leave for unwell grandparents or Umrah during school term time.
- 13. Unauthorised absences and repeated lateness may lead to an administrative charge or permanent exclusion. A charge of £100 may be applied for each unauthorised absence, starting from the third absence, to support catching up on missed lessons. Five unauthorised absences may result in permanent exclusion, while three late arrivals could lead to disciplinary action. If a child wishes to continue at Darul Uloom, parents must appeal or reapply for admission. (See attendance policy)

14. Darul Uloom reserves the right to withdraw your child from entering a GCSE examination if internal assessments reveal a strong likelihood of failure or a negative impact on other qualifications. Alternative arrangements or qualifications will be offered where suitable.

19. The school will recover any unpaid fees using an authorised debt collector if fees are not paid. And additional charges for the services will be added to the debt. 20. Darul Uloom reserves the full right to alter, add to, or amend the rules and regulations as and when necessary.

^{15.} If a student wishes to leave the school, one term notice is required, and all fees for this period must be cleared prior to leaving. If this notice is not provided, the deposit will not be refunded.

^{16.} If a student is permanently excluded due to his misconduct, the parent or guardian will be responsible for paying a full-term fee, and the deposit will not be refunded. 17. All students and parents are required to observe the rules and policies of the school.

^{18.} If a student receives detention longer than 20 minutes outside school hours, parents will be notified. Parents are required to arrange for the student to attend all detentions that are outside school hours. (See Behaviour Policy)
