
Be self-disciplined and learn to prioritize correctly in life and you will find problems minimize or even disappear by the Help of the Almighty."

Alhamdulillah, Darul Uloom Islamic High School has officially registered for the Aid for Syria program as part of the Association of Muslim Schools (AMS).


